Creating Cascading Style Sheets: Multiple Link Colors on the Same Page

- 1. Creating multi-colored links on the same page.
 - a. Highlight the text or link on the page
 - b. Select Text, CSS Styles, New
 - **c.** Type in a **Name** for the CSS in the **New CSS Style** window that opens, select Class in **Selector Type**, and **Define** in **New Style Sheet File.** Refer to Figure 1

New CSS Style


Selector Type: Oclass (can apply to any tag)



- 2. Click Ok
- 3. Another Window Opens, Find the CSS folder and save the New CSS in there by typing in the name to agree with the Name you typed in for the New CSS Style (as you continue to work with CSS, your naming could vary, but for now, make them the same). Refer to Figure 2.



4. Click on Save.

- 5. Another Window opens. Select all that you want. See Figure 3. Figure 3
- 6. Click OK.



- 7. Now you need to do this for each new CSS.
- 8. Using the CSS.
 - a. Highlight text and then in Page Properties the Style you want. Repeat for each text of choice.
